<u>Approve Monthly Town Board Meeting Minutes:</u> Motion was made by Chairman Curns to approve the December 20, 2010 Monthly Town Board Minutes as printed. A second to the motion was made by Sup. Wundrock. Motion carried. <u>Approve January 7<sup>th</sup> Special Town Board Meeting Minutes:</u> Motion was made by Sup. Wundrock & seconded by Sup. Freeman to approve the minutes of the January 7<sup>th</sup> Special Town Board Meeting. Motion carried.

<u>Treasurer: Approve Monthly Treasurer's Report:</u> Motion was made by Sup. Wundrock/Sup. Freeman to approve the December 31<sup>st</sup> Treasurer's Report as presented & read. Motion carried. Treasurer Grove advised that Tax Collection Dates are as follows: Friday & Monday, January 28<sup>th</sup> and 31<sup>st</sup> from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. each day.

<u>Budget/Vouchers:</u> (a)<u>Approval & Payment of Vouchers:</u> Motion was made by Sup. Wundrock/Chairman Curns to approve payment of Vouchers 23263 through 23310, dated January 1, 2011 through January 17, 2011, for a total of \$1,633,971.25. Motion carried. (b)<u>Designate LRIP Funds Received (Tank Road Project) - \$26,520.32</u>: Motion to designate the \$26,520.32 received from the LRIP, Tank Road Project into the Road Construction/Maintenance Account was made by Sup. Wundrock and seconded by Sup. Freeman. Motion carried.

<u>Public Forum - Town of Mukwa Residents:</u> <u>Rick Seater-Guth's Resort</u>: Mr. Seater was present to clarify fire protection for his area of the Town. Mr. Seater just adjusted his insurance and now pays \$1,000 more due to fire rating. The Town has not contracted with the Weyauwega Fire Department for several years due to the excessive cost. New London Fire Department covers the entire Town, again there is a reciprocity agreement in case of extreme emergency. Recommended that Mr. Seater shop other insurance companies. Mr. Seater also questioned why he didn't get plowed out – the Town has a reciprocal agreement with the Town of Royalton, we plow Ostrander Road for them & they are supposed to plow Deer Haven for us. Chairman Curns will contact Town of Royalton Chairman Bork regarding snowplow issues. <u>Arnie Heise-Faskell Road</u>: Mr. Heise had concerns about snowplowing on his corner – snowplow driver putting snow in driveway or burying the mailbox. Snowplow drivers will be advised.

<u>County Supervisor</u>: County Supervisor, Bob Flease was unable to attend but had contacted Sup. Wundrock to advise that Towns and Cities are going together to buy signs. Clerk Zielinski has spoken with the County Highway Shop and will get prices from them.

Board has received many calls regarding damage caused by this outage, most in \$1,000 - \$2,000 range, but up to \$10,000. The Board has designated Supervisor Wundrock as the contact person for this issue. The Board is working with We Energies to attempt to set up a Town Hall style meeting. This will be added to February's Agenda.

Landfill on Hutchison/Cut-Off Road: (a)Set 2011 Annual Brush Drop-Off Dates: 2011 Dates were set as the following-Saturdays from 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. : April 30<sup>th</sup>, May 14<sup>th</sup>, May 28<sup>th</sup>, June 18<sup>th</sup>, July 16<sup>th</sup>, August 20<sup>th</sup>, September 17<sup>th</sup>, October 8<sup>th</sup> and October 22<sup>nd</sup>. (b)Sign at Entrance: Chairman Curns inquired as to the possibility of installing a sign with dates/hours ie. third Saturday from 9 – 3. Approval-Updates/Revisions to Town of Mukwa Ordinance 01-07 Land Division & Subdivision Regulations for a Public Hearing:

In order to meet the statutory requirements of amended §236, Wis. Stats, the following revisions need to be made to the Land Division/Subdivision Ordinance:

XX.10(10): Revise the first sentence to read: All land division, plats, or Certified Survey Maps, upon receipt of final approval by the Town Board or its designees, shall be recorded in the Office of the Register of Deeds by the land divider at the cost of the land divider *within twelve months after the last approval and 36 months from the first approval.* XX.10(17): Add the following sentence at the end of the paragraph: *If the plat isto be developed in phases, the amount of the surety bond shall be limited to the phase currently being constructed.*

3. XX.50: Revise the paragraph to read: Upon approval of all corrections addressed in the preliminary and final plat reviews the Subdivider shall submit a final Plat *within twelve months after the last approval and 36 months from the first approval* for recording with the Waupaca County Register of Deeds in accordance with Sec. 236.25, Wisconsin Statutes.

Motion to approve said updates/revisions to Town of Mukwa Ordinance 01-07 Land Division & Subdivision Regulations for a Public Hearing was made by Supervisor Wundrock and seconded by Supervisor Freeman. Motion carried.

<u>Set Date for Public Hearing – March 2, 2011 at 7:00 p.m.</u>: Motion was made by Supervisor Wundrock to set the date for the Public Hearing as Wednesday, March 2, 2011 at 7:00 p.m. to be held at the Mukwa Town Hall. Motion seconded by Supervisor Freeman. Motion was edited by Supervisor Wundrock to include a Public Hearing allowing for Public Comment on the Town of Mukwa Zoning Map and on the Updates/Revisions to Town of Mukwa Ordinance 01-07 Land Division & Subdivision Regulations will be held on Wednesday, March 2<sup>nd</sup> at 7:00 p.m. in the Mukwa Town Hall. Edited motion was seconded by Supervisor Freeman. Motion carried.
