<u>Brenda Freeman-2014 Election</u>: Brenda was present to introduce herself, with a brief presentation to explain her qualifications and experience. Brenda is the daughter of long-serving Town of Mukwa Supervisor, Neil Freeman.

<u>Review/Approve-Gold Cross Ambulance Service Agreement:</u> All Board members received & reviewed the Agreement. Motion to approve the "Ambulance Service Agreement between City of Weyauwega, Town of Weyauwega, and portions of the Towns of Royalton and Mukwa and Gold Cross Ambulance Service, Inc." was made by Supervisor Shaw with the second to the motion made by Supervisor Manske. Motion carried. Chairman Curns signed the Agreement.

Roads: (a)Monthly Report: Brent Wisner was hired in November, but notified the Town that his back was really bothering him & there might be times he would be unable to work. Chairman Curns contacted Corey Prinsen, Mid-State Asphalt, as he had plowed for the Town in the past, but phone calls were not returned. Recommendation by Supervisor Manske for Rick Bonnell to plow. Chairman Curns contacted MCC regarding snowplowing - they would be able to help. Motion was made by Supervisor Manske with a second by Supervisor Shaw, that in case of a snow emergency & equipment break-down that Chairman Curns is authorized to contact MCC. Motion carried. Discussion. Motion was made by Chairman Curns with a second by Supervisor Shaw that if Chairman Curns is out of town that Supervisor Manske will be the back-up for snow emergencies. Motion carried. (b)Road Equipment-Report/Repairs/ Purchases Needed: (c)Fahrner's Crack-Sealing – Follow-up: All 2013 work completed. Clerk Zielinski contacted Bill Glatz to get a 2014 list of work. Mr. Glatz indicated that he would go out after spring thaw to reassess & will give us an update at that time. (d)<u>Waupaca County Highway Department Tree Cutting Program:</u> Discussion. Town used this program in the past & it was felt that the Town could get a better price. (e)Culverts-Follow-up: Supervisor Shaw got the tree out of the Mechanic St./Broadway St. culvert & J-K Trenching was able to blast water through. This culvert will need to be reassessed in 2014. (f)Possible 2014 Road Projects-Discussion: Current possibilities for repair would be a portion of Ebert (Dey to Huntley); Ostrander Road from the bridge to County Trunk X & portions of Cut-Off Road. Also discussed doing some chip sealing projects such as Mulroy Road & Frances Lane and the Ostrander Road culvert.
