

ADDENDUM ONE TO ORDINANCE 3-99
RULES FOR PROTECTING ROAD SHOULDERS AND BLACKTOP
Private Access Road and Driveway Requirements

If you are obtaining a building permit in an area where the road is paved, this form pertains to you.

A) A gravel driveway (including culvert if required) must be in place before any excavating or construction can take place.

B) All equipment entering the property **must** use this prepared entry,

Or;

Use a secondary, temporary graveled entry, which is the same level as the blacktop. This entry must then be removed and the shoulder and ditch restored to its initial condition before an occupancy permit will be given.

C) Any damage to the blacktop and/or shoulder of the road will be billed, by the Town of Mukwa, to the person(s) responsible for (taking out) the building permit and/or the property owner(s).

D) It shall further be the responsibility of the person(s) who have taken out the building permit to have the **PROPER ENTRIES** installed prior to any construction. It will also be imperative that the above-said person(s) notify all parties/firms (affected by this ordinance). Including the property owner(s), contractors, sub-contractors, and suppliers.

E) The Town of Mukwa reserves the right to place any unpaid damage(s) onto the property-owner's next tax bill. This shall be categorized under "special assessments".


This addendum to Ordinance 3-99 will take effect upon passage by the Town Board of the Town of Mukwa and publication according to law.




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
