

ORDINANCE NO. 2-83

An Ordinance Prohibiting Issuance  
of Alcohol Beverage Licenses for  
Nonpayment of Taxes, Assessments and Claims

THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF MUKWA, WISCONSIN, DO ORDAIN AS  
FOLLOWS:

Ordinance No. 2-83 relating to the regulation of alcoholic  
beverages in the Town of Mukwa, County of Waupaca, State of Wisconsin  
is created to read as follows:

Section 1. LICENSE REGULATIONS. (1) DELINQUENT TAXES, ASSESSMENTS,  
ETC.

(a) PREMISES. No initial or renewal alcoholic beverage license  
shall be granted for any premises for which taxes, assessments or other  
claim of the Town or County are delinquent and unpaid.

(b) PERSONS. No initial or renewal alcoholic beverage license shall  
be granted to any person:

1. Delinquent in payment of any taxes, assessments or other claims  
owed to the Town.

2. Delinquent in payment of a forfeiture resulting from a violation  
of any ordinance of the Town.

3. Delinquent in payment to the state or any state taxes owed.

4. Delinquent in payment to the County or any County taxes owed.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and  
publication as provided by law.
